27th Sunday after Pentecost/Martyrs Means, Hermogenes, and Eugraphus, of Alexandria

"Lord I Call..." Tone 2

Lord, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! Hear <u>me</u>, O Lord! <u>Lord</u>, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! Receive the <u>voice</u> of my prayer, when I <u>call</u> upon You!// Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an evening <u>sac</u>rifice!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord!

Reader reads the rest of Psalm 140 and Psalm 141 on pgs 31 & 32 in the pew book, then:

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name! Tone 2

Come, let us worship the Word of God

begotten of the Father before all ages,

and incarnate of the Virgin Mary!

Having endured the Cross,

He was buried as He Himself desired.//

And having risen from the dead, He saved me, an erring man.

V. (9) The righteous will surround me; for You will deal bountifully with me.

Christ our Savior

nailed to the Cross the bond against us,

He voided it and destroyed the dominion of death.//

We fall down before His Resurrection on the third day.

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice!

With the Archangels

let us praise the Resur<u>rec</u>tion of Christ!

He is our <u>Sav</u>ior, our Re<u>deem</u>er.

He is coming with awesome glory and mighty power//

to judge the world which He made.

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

The Angel proclaimed You,

the crucified and buried Master.

He told the women: "Come, see the place where He lay!

He is risen as He said,

for He is almighty."

We worship You, O only immortal One.//

Have mercy on us, O Christ, the Giver of life!

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

By Your Cross, You destroyed the <u>curse</u> of the tree.

By Your burial You destroyed the dominion of death.

By Your <u>rising</u>, You enlightened the <u>race</u> of man.//

O Benefactor, Christ our God, glory to You!

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

The gates of death opened to You from <u>fear</u>, O Lord.

When the guards of hell saw You they were afraid,

for You demolished the gates of brass and smashed the iron chains.//

You have led us from the darkness and shadows of death, and have <u>brok</u>en our bonds.

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord! Let us come and worship in the house of the Lord, singing the hymn of salvation: Cleanse our <a href="mailto:sins.com/sins.com/house

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities. **Tone 1** (for the Martyrs) (O all-praised martyrs)

O all-<u>glo</u>rious Martyr <u>Me</u>nas,

when your heels were struck,

your eyes put out, and your God-speaking tongue removed,

you endured with steadfastness, <u>look</u>ing for divine rewards.//

Therefore pray that God may grant peace and great <u>mer</u>cy to our souls!

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

The glorious Hermogenes

desired the severing of his hands and feet.

Beholding the fire, he showed forth a greater burning of heart

as he clung firmly unto his God.//

Now we pray to Him that He may grant peace and great mercy to our souls!

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

Your <u>limbs</u> were broken, O <u>wise</u> saints;

you were cast into the depths of the sea.

Having drowned the malice of the serpent,

you were guided by the hands of the Most High to the calm haven of sweetness.//

Therefore pray that God may grant peace and great <u>mer</u>cy to our souls!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 2 The shadow of the Law passed when grace came;

as the Bush burned, yet was not consumed, /so the Virgin gave birth, yet remained a Virgin./

The Righteous Sun has risen instead of a <u>pillar</u> of flame.// Instead of Moses, Christ, the Sal<u>va</u>tion of our souls.

APOSTICHA

Tone 2 Your Resurrection, O Christ our <u>Sav</u>ior, has enlightened the whole <u>u</u>niverse, re<u>call</u>ing Your creation.// Glory to You, O almighty Lord!

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

By the Tree You destroyed the curse of the Tree, O <u>Savior</u>.

By Your burial You mortified the <u>majesty</u> of death.

You have en<u>light</u>ened our race by Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion.//

O Giver of life, Christ our God, <u>glory</u> to You!

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

When You were seen nailed to the <u>Cross</u>, O Christ, You restored the beauty of Your <u>crea</u>tures. The <u>sol</u>diers showed their inhumanity when they pierced Your <u>side</u> with a spear. The Hebrews, not knowing Your <u>power</u>, asked that Your <u>tomb</u> might be sealed, but through the <u>mer</u>cy of Your com<u>passion</u>, You ac<u>cepted</u> the tomb and rose on the <u>third</u> day!// O Lord, <u>glory</u> to You!

received grace to dispel the aff<u>lic</u>tions of the infirm and to work wonders both while a<u>live</u> and after death.

It is a <u>truly great won</u>der that naked bones pour forth <u>healing</u>.// Glory to our <u>only God</u> and Creator!
