TONE 1

"Lord I Call..." Tone 1

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>eve</u>ning <u>sac</u>rifice!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord!

Reader reads the rest of Psalm 140 and Psalm 141 on pgs 31 & 32 in the pew book, then:

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name! **Tone 1** Accept our evening prayers, O <u>ho</u>ly Lord! Grant us re<u>mis</u>sion of sins,// for You alone have manifested the Resurrection to the world.

V. (9) The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.

En<u>cir</u>cle S<u>i</u>on and surround her, O <u>people!</u>
Give <u>glory</u> in her to the One Who <u>rose</u> from the dead!
For <u>He</u> is <u>our</u> God,//
Who has delivered us from our trans<u>gres</u>sions!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice! Come, O people, let us hymn and fall down before Christ, glorifying His Resurrection from the dead! For He is our God,//
Who has delivered the world from the Enemy's deceit!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications!

Be glad, O heavens!

Sound trumpets, O foundations of the earth!

Sing in gladness, O mountains!

Behold Emmanuel has <u>nailed</u> our <u>sins</u> to the Cross!

Granting <u>life</u>, He has <u>slain</u> death.//

He has resurrected Adam as the Lover of man.

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

Let us praise Him

Who voluntarily was crucified in the <u>flesh</u> for our sake.

He suffered, was buried, but rose from the dead.

By Orthodoxy confirm Your Church, O Christ.//

Grant peace for our life as the gracious <u>Lov</u>er of man.

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

We <u>stand</u> before Your life-bearing tomb unworthily, O <u>Christ</u> God, offering glory to Your ineffable com<u>passion</u>.

You have ac<u>cept</u>ed the Cross and death, O <u>sin</u>less One// to grant Resurrection to the world as the Lover of man.

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord! <u>Let</u> us <u>praise</u> the Word,

co-eternal with the Father.

He in<u>eff</u>ably came forth from the <u>virginal</u> womb.

He freely accepted the Cross and death for our sake.

He was <u>raised</u> in <u>glory</u>.//

Glory to You, O lifegiving Lord, the Savior of our souls!

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities. **Tone 4** (for Prophet Zephaniah) (Called from on high)

As a divine prophet, herald and proclaimer of the <u>words</u> of God, receiving the radiance of divine splendor in <u>purity</u> of mind,

you were $re\underline{vealed}$ as the divinely inspired mouth of the \underline{Spir} it.

You proclaim the things He re<u>vealed</u> to you,

telling all the <u>na</u>tions, O most <u>hon</u>ored one,

of the Kingdom of Christ and the salvation that is <u>giv</u>en to men.//

Entreat Him to save and enlighten our souls!

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!

You fittingly shine forth in the vision of God, O divinely inspired one,

honored with grace and a chief place among the <u>Proph</u>ets,

re<u>ceiv</u>ing the <u>bless</u>ings of God.

Now that you have boldness towards the All-Good One and <u>sym</u>pathy for us,

we honor you for having the eloquence of God, being honorable and pleasing to Him.

Never cease to pray on behalf of those who <u>praise</u> you in faith,//

that He may deliver us from misfortunes and save our souls!

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever.

You revealed Your Prophet, O Immortal One,

to be a living cloud pouring forth the water of eternal life.

You sent him forth, giving him freely the All-holy Spirit,

consubstantial with You, the Almighty Father,

and Your Son, who shone forth from Your Essence,

by which he prophesied the saving coming of Christ our God,//

proclaiming salvation to all the <u>na</u>tions.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Tone 1 Let us <u>praise</u> the Virgin <u>Mary!</u>

The gate of heaven, the glory of the world!

The <u>song</u> of the angels, the beauty of the <u>faithful!</u>

She was born of man, yet gave birth to God!

She was re<u>vealed</u> as the heaven, as the temple of the <u>God</u>head!

She destroyed the wall of enmity!

She com<u>menced</u> the peace; she opened the <u>Kingdom!</u>

Since she is our foundation of faith,

our defender is the Lord Whom she bore!

Courage! Courage! O People of God!

For <u>Christ</u> will destroy our <u>en</u>emies//

since He is all powerful.

Tone 1 We have been <u>freed</u> from <u>suf</u>ferings by Your <u>suf</u>fering, O Christ.

We have been delivered from cor<u>rup</u>tion by Your <u>Res</u>ur<u>rec</u>tion.//
O Lord, glory to You!

V. The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!

Let creation rejoice!

Let the <u>heav</u>ens be glad!

Let the <u>na</u>tions clap their hands with <u>glad</u>ness,

for Christ our Savior has <u>nailed</u> our <u>sins</u> to the Cross.

Slaying death, He has given life.//

He has resurrected fallen Adam as the Lover of man.

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved.

As <u>King</u> of <u>heav</u>en and earth, / You were voluntarily crucified in Your <u>love</u> for man. / <u>Hell</u> was angered when it <u>met</u> You below. / Adam rose seeing You, the Creator, <u>un</u>der the earth. / O wonder! How has the Life of all tasted death?

You enlightened the world which cries://

O Lord, Who rose from the dead, glory to You!

V. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore!

The myrrhbearing women came with haste to Your tomb,

bearing myrrh and lamenting.

Not <u>find</u>ing Your most pure <u>bo</u>dy,

they learned from the angel of the new and glorious wonder.

They told the Apostles://

"The Lord is risen, granting the world great mercy."
