8th Sunday after Pentecost / Apostles Silas and Silvanus of the Seventy, and those with them

"Lord I Call..." Tone 7

Lord, I call upon You, hear me! Hear me, O Lord!
Lord, I call upon You, hear me!
Receive the voice of my prayer, when I call upon You!//
Hear me, O Lord!

Let my prayer arise in Your <u>sight</u> as <u>incense</u>, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>evening sacrifice!// Hear me</u>, O Lord!

After "Lord I Call..." the Reader reads the rest of Ps. 140 & Ps. 141 on pgs 31 in the pew book, then: STICHERA

V. (10) Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name! **Tone 7**Come, let us rejoice in the Lord,
Who destroyed the dominion of death!

Let us sing to Him with the bodiless hosts,
for He enlightened the race of man!//
O our Maker and Savior, glory to You!

V. (9) The righteous will surround me; for You will deal bountifully with me. You en<u>dured</u> the Cross and <u>bur</u>ial for our sake.

By Your <u>death</u>, You destroyed <u>death</u> as God.

We fall <u>down</u> before Your Resurrection on the <u>third</u> day,//
O <u>Sav</u>ior, <u>glory</u> to You!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice! When the Apostles beheld the Resurrection of the Maker, they were amazed and sang the angelic praise.

This is the glory of the Church.

This is the richness of the Kingdom.//
O Lord, crucified for our sake, glory to You!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications! You were held by lawless men, O Christ,
but to me, You are God, and I am not ashamed.
You were smitten on the cheek, but I do not deny You.
You were nailed to the Cross and I do not conceal it,
for I glory in Your Resurrection: Your death is my life.//
O Almighty Lord and Lover of man, glory to You!

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

Ful<u>fill</u>ing the prophecy of <u>Da</u>vid, <u>Christ</u> manifested His greatness in Sion to the dis<u>ci</u>ples. He is <u>praised</u> and always <u>glo</u>rified, to<u>get</u>her with the Father and the Holy <u>Spir</u>it. At <u>first</u> as the Word, He was <u>bod</u>iless, but <u>then</u> He took flesh and was <u>slain</u> for our sake.// He rose in power as the Lover of man!

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

You des<u>cend</u>ed into hell as You <u>willed</u>, O Christ, over<u>throw</u>ing death as God, and rising on the third day as <u>Mas</u>ter! With Your<u>self</u> You raised Adam from the bonds of hell and from cor<u>rup</u>tion!// Glory to Your Resur<u>rec</u>tion, O only <u>Lov</u>er of man!

- V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord! You were <u>placed</u> in the tomb, O Lord, as <u>one</u> asleep. On the <u>third</u> day You rose in <u>power</u>, raising <u>Ad</u>am with Yourself from the cor<u>rup</u>tion of death// <u>as</u> the <u>Almighty</u> One!
- V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver Israel from all his iniquities. **Tone 4** (for the Apostles) (Thou hast given a sign)
 Enlightened by the lightning flashes of the Spirit, you went about the whole world illumining the faithful.
 O all-wise ones, as Apostles of the Word, you diminished the darkness of the depths of ignorance.
 Therefore we rejoice today as we celebrate your light bearing festival// that brings us sanctification.
- V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples!
 You sprinkled heavenly rain to the ends of the earth as blest clouds refreshing the souls of the faithful with divine grace. You choked the alien tares of ungodliness, bringing to maturity the fruitful souls of men.//
 Therefore, O Apostles, we honor you in praises!
- V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever. Let us come together and honor in faith the most excellent <u>Si</u>las, with Andronicus, Epenétus and <u>Cre</u>scens, and in <u>love</u> let us honor <u>Silvan</u>us with them! They are heralds of the faith who pour out rivers of <u>healing</u>,// removing attacks of all the passions by the divine <u>Spi</u>rit.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.
