"Lord I Call..." Tone 1

Lord, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! <u>Hear</u> me, O Lord! <u>Lord</u>, I call upon You, <u>hear</u> me! Re<u>ceive</u> the <u>voice</u> of my prayer, when I <u>call</u> up<u>on</u> You!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord! Let my <u>prayer</u> arise in Your sight as <u>in</u>cense, and <u>let</u> the lifting <u>up</u> of my hands be an <u>evening sac</u>rifice!// <u>Hear me</u>, O Lord!

After "Lord I Call..." the Reader reads the rest of Ps. 140 & Ps. 141 on pgs 31 in the pew book, then:

V. (10) *Bring my soul out of prison, that I may give thanks to Your Name!* **Tone 1** Accept our evening prayers, O <u>ho</u>ly Lord! Grant us re<u>mis</u>sion of sins,// for You alone have manifested the Resur<u>rec</u>tion to the world.

V. (9) *The righteous will surround me, for You will deal bountifully with me.* Encircle Sion and surround her, O people! Give glory in her to the One Who rose from the dead! For <u>He</u> is <u>our</u> God,// Who has delivered us from our trans<u>gres</u>sions!

V. (8) Out of the depths I cry to You, O Lord. Lord, hear my voice! <u>Come</u>, O <u>people</u>, let us hymn and fall <u>down</u> before Christ, <u>glorifying His Resurrection from the dead!</u> For <u>He</u> is <u>our</u> God,// Who has delivered the world from the <u>En</u>emy's deceit!

V. (7) Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications! Be glad, O heavens! Sound trumpets, O foundations of the earth! Sing in gladness, O mountains! Behold Emmanuel has <u>nailed</u> our <u>sins</u> to the Cross! Granting <u>life</u>, He has <u>slain</u> death.// He has resurrected Adam as the <u>Lov</u>er of man.

V. (6) If You, O Lord, should mark iniquities, Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You.

Tone 2*(for All Saints of America)Come, let us praise the saints of North America,
holy hierarchs, venerable monastics, and glorious martyrs,
pious men, women, and children, both known and unknown!
Through their words and deeds, in various walks of life,
by the grace of the Spirit they achieved true holiness.
Now as they stand in the presence of Christ Who glorified them,//
they pray for us, who celebrate their memory with love.

V. (5) For Your Name's sake I wait for You, O Lord. My soul has waited for Your word; my soul has hoped on the Lord.

Come, let us as<u>sem</u>ble today and glorify the luminaries of the North A<u>mer</u>ican lands, the glorious <u>mar</u>tyrs and holy bishops who con<u>firmed</u> our faith, the righteous dwellers in the wilderness and guides of the <u>spir</u>itual life! Let us cry out to <u>them</u> in joy:// "All Saints of North America, known and unknown, pray to <u>God</u> for us!"

V. (4) From the morning watch until night, from the morning watch, let Israel hope on the Lord! As the <u>bright</u>est sun, as the brilliance of the <u>Morning Star</u>, the precious <u>feast</u> of the saints of North America has <u>dawned</u> for us, to illumine us and to set our <u>hearts</u> on fire, to imitate their <u>god</u>ly lives,// and to follow their example of <u>zeal</u> for God.

V. (3) For with the Lord there is mercy and with Him is plenteous redemption, and He will deliver *Israel from all his iniquities.*

Come, let us as<u>sem</u>ble today and let us praise the elect of North A<u>mer</u>ica! Having <u>fought</u> the good fight, you have perse<u>vered</u> in the faith, receiving your crowns of <u>vic</u>tory from God. Beseech Him to deliver from every calamity and <u>sor</u>row// all who keep your holy memory in <u>faith</u> and in love!

V. (2) Praise the Lord, all nations! Praise Him, all peoples! **Tone 6** (for All Saints of America) (Having placed all their hope)

The earth rejoices and the <u>heav</u>ens are glad,

O venerable Saints of America,

praising your labors and lives, your spiritual fortitude and <u>pur</u>ity of heart.

By driving away a multitude of <u>de</u>mons

and enlightening many people with the light of the Orthodox Faith,//you have confirmed our land.

V. (1) For His mercy is confirmed on us, and the truth of the Lord endures forever. Rejoice, O mountains of Pennsylvania; leap for joy, O waters of the Great Lakes; rise up, O fertile plains of Canada; for the elect of Christ who dwelt in you are glorified, men and women who left their homes for a new land! With faith, hope, and patience as their armor, they courageously fought the good fight. Comforted by the beauty of the Orthodox Faith, they labored in mines and mills, they tilled the land, they braved the challenges of the great <u>cities</u>, enduring many hardships and sufferings. Never failing to worship God in spirit and truth and unyielding in devotion to His most pure Mother, they erected many temples to His <u>glo</u>ry. Come, O assembly of the Orthodox, and with love let us praise the holy men, women, and <u>children</u>, those known to us and those known only to God, and let us cry out to them:// "Rejoice, all Saints of North America and pray to God for us!"

Rejoice, every province, state, <u>city</u>, and town, which raised <u>up</u> citizens of the heavenly <u>King</u>dom! Rejoice, our venerable Father Herman, first <u>saint</u> of our land! Rejoice O Martyrs Juvenaly and <u>Pe</u>ter, for your <u>blood</u> has watered the seed of faith planted in A<u>las</u>ka! Rejoice, O holy Hierarchs: Innocent, Tikhon, Nicholas, <u>Ra</u>phael, and John! Rejoice, O holy Fathers Alexis, John, and all you <u>right</u>eous priests! Rejoice, all Saints of North A<u>mer</u>ica, for your <u>light</u> has shone forth to the <u>ends</u> of the earth!// We beseech you to pray to Christ our God that our souls may be saved!

now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen. **Tone 1** *(Theotokion – Dogmatikon)* Let us <u>praise</u> the Virgin <u>Mary!</u> /The gate of heaven, the <u>glory</u> of the world! The <u>song</u> of the angels, the beauty of the <u>faithful!</u> /She was born of <u>man</u>, yet gave <u>birth</u> to God! She was re<u>vealed</u> as the heaven, as the temple of the <u>God</u>head! /She destroyed the wall of <u>en</u>mity! She com<u>menced</u> the peace; she opened the <u>Kingdom!</u> /Since she is <u>our</u> foun<u>da</u>tion of faith, our de<u>fen</u>der is the <u>Lord</u> Whom she bore! /Courage! Courage! O <u>People</u> of God! For <u>Christ</u> will destroy our <u>enemies</u>// since He is all <u>pow</u>erful.

APOSTICHA

Tone 1 We have been <u>freed</u> from <u>suf</u>ferings by Your <u>suf</u>fering, O Christ. <u>We</u> have been delivered from cor<u>rup</u>tion by Your Resurrection.//O Lord, glory to You!

V. *The Lord is King; He is robed in majesty!* Let creation rejoice! Let the <u>heavens be glad!</u> Let the <u>nations clap their hands with gladness,</u> for Christ our Savior has <u>nailed</u> our <u>sins</u> to the Cross. Slaying <u>death</u>, He has given <u>life</u>.// He has resurrected fallen Adam as the <u>Lover of man</u>.

V. For He has established the world, so that it shall never be moved. As <u>King</u> of <u>heav</u>en and earth, You were voluntarily crucified in Your <u>love</u> for man. <u>Hell</u> was angered when it <u>met</u> You below. Adam rose seeing You, the Cre<u>a</u>tor, <u>un</u>der the earth. O <u>won</u>der! How has the Life of all <u>tast</u>ed death? You enlightened the <u>world</u> which cries:// O Lord, Who rose from the dead, <u>glory</u> to You!

V. Holiness befits Your house, O Lord, forevermore! The <u>myrrh</u>bearing women came with <u>haste</u> to Your tomb, bearing myrrh and la<u>ment</u>ing. Not <u>find</u>ing Your most pure <u>bo</u>dy, they learned from the angel of the new and <u>glo</u>rious <u>won</u>der. They <u>told</u> the A<u>pos</u>tles:// "The Lord is risen, granting the world great <u>mer</u>cy."

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit; **Tone 4** (for All Saints of America) Today, as we celebrate the memory of all the Saints of North America, let us praise them as is <u>fitting</u>, for they <u>lived</u> all of Christ's be<u>at</u>itudes. Deprived of material wealth, they became rich in <u>spirit</u>; meek, they in<u>herited</u> the earth; mourning, they were <u>com</u>forted; thirsting for righteousness, they were <u>sat</u>isfied; merciful, they ob<u>tained mer</u>cy; pure in heart, they beheld the <u>image</u> of God; as peacemakers, they became God's <u>chil</u>dren; persecuted and tortured for righteousness' sake, they now rejoice in <u>heaven</u>;// and they pray fervently to the Lord that He may have <u>mer</u>cy on our souls.

Tone 5 Let us sound a hymn on the trumpet and praise with one accord the Protectress of our land, our Queen, the Theotokos: Rejoice, for you have crowned our land with your favor, pouring abundant grace upon it! Therefore, the Church in America joyously celebrates your precious protection and commemorates the multitude of your miracles. And now deprive us not of your mercies, O Lady! Look with <u>favor</u> upon us in our adversities and af<u>flic</u>tions// and raise us up by your powerful intercession!

Tone 1 When the <u>stone</u> had been sealed by the <u>Jews</u>, while the soldiers were guarding Your most pure body, You rose on the third day, O Savior, granting life to the world. The <u>pow</u>ers of heaven therefore cried to You, O <u>Giv</u>er of Life: "Glory to Your Resurrection, O Christ! Glory to Your Kingdom!// Glory to Your dispensation, O Lover of mankind!"
